Step 3: Pay a \$5 per week to reserve your child’s spot, pay in full Friday before the week your camper is attending, and turn in any additional required forms.

Campers will participate in swim lessons and free swim at both our Main Campus indoor pool and our JCC Logan Campus outdoor pool, weather permitting. Grades 2-4 will visit Logan Campus on Monday, Grades K-1 will visit on Tuesday. Grades 5-8 will visit on Wednesday. All of camp will visit on Thursday. Field Trip Wednesdays will follow alternate schedules based on the trip. Campers may not participate in swimming or activities on these days.





Leadership in Training Program

For teens entering grades 9-10

The Leadership in Training (LIT) program is a leadership development curriculum created for 9th and 10th graders interested in becoming a camp counselor and developing their skills as a leader in their school and community. The eight week summer session provides leadership training, activity programming experience, self-awareness workshops, and team-building exercises for young teens.

Camp JCC's LIT program is not for everyone; it is designed for teens that have an interest in working with younger children and have a desire to be in a leadership role. LITs will be selected based on an application process. Space is limited.
